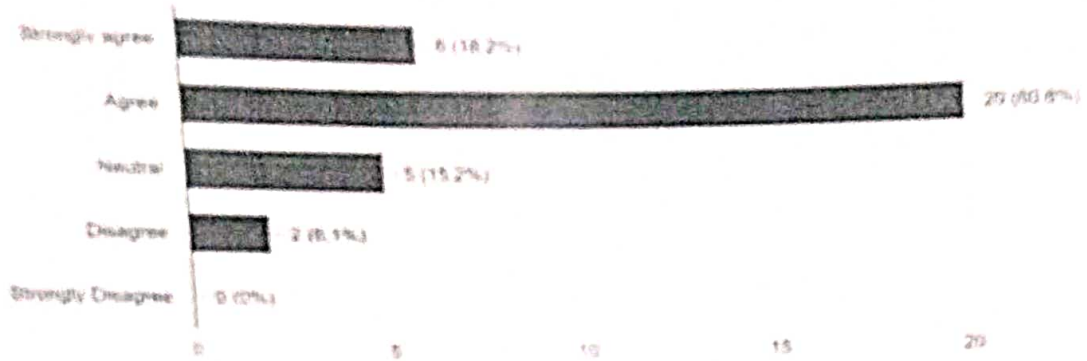
Following are some of the key suggestions of the teachers:

- Research activities should be promoted in the colleges.
- Students are a bit more irregular having less interest in studies in spite of everyday motivation by teachers. If mindset of students changes about their priorities and importance of education, then it will be a boon. Apart from this, College administration, all the teaching and non-teaching staff members are very cordial, supportive, hardworking, dedicated and punctual.
- There is a requirement of new block for PG classes and smart rooms to cater to the needs of the students in present scenario.
- There should be a separate portion for teachers in library with proper sitting arrangement. So that they can enrich their knowledge.
- IT Infrastructure should be up to date
- Shortage of staff is a big issue and syllabus is prepared by only university teachers. College staff must be given chance to give their suggestion regarding syllabus.

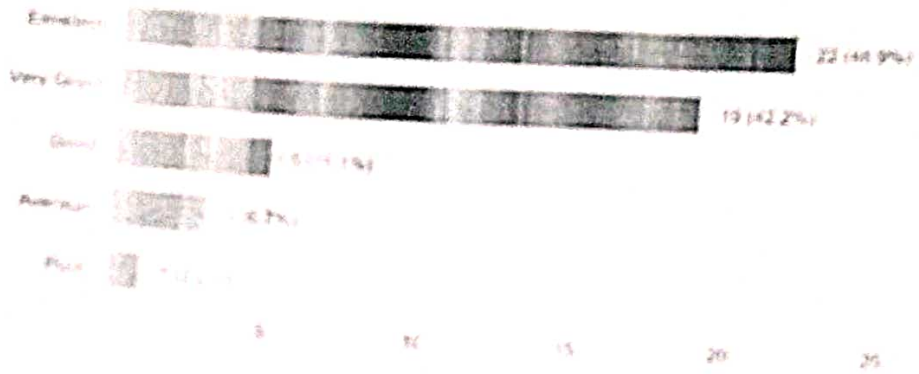

Following are some of the key suggestions of the Alumni:

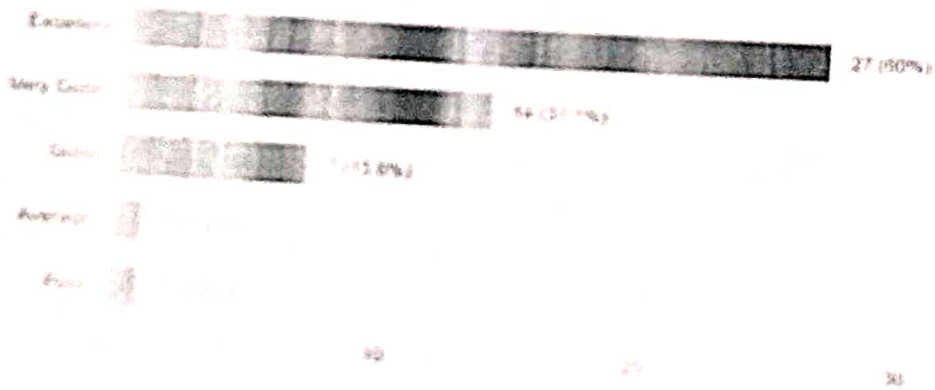
- Need of a Bus Stop in front of the college
